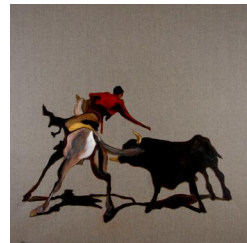

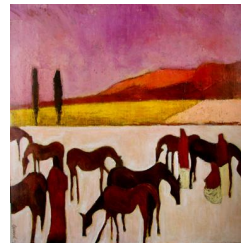

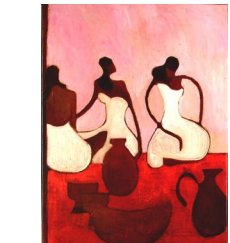

Marc Dehareng was born in the mid-1960s. An economist by training, Marc Dehareng lives in the Namur region of Belgium.

HIS CAREER:

Trained at the Beaux-Arts in Namur, this artist has been painting for nearly 30 years and draws inspiration from his travels in Europe, Africa and Asia. He participates in numerous exhibitions in Belgium.

HIS WORK:

Marc Dehareng works mainly in large formats. The tones he uses are warm, reminiscent of the intense browns and reds of African soils: 'What interests me is the light, the particular light you find there, the play of colours, the way people dress.' Between ornamentalism and orientalism, his scenes of streets, markets and hammams are reminiscent of Gauguin's work in Tahiti. Marc Dehareng also continues his ornamental research by stretching the silhouettes of his horsemen in a play of moving curves.
