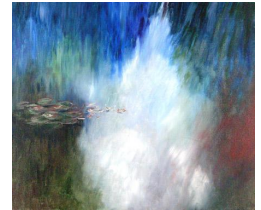

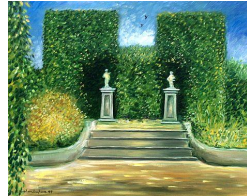

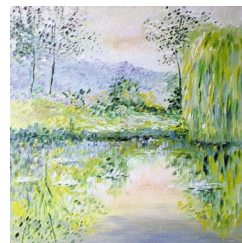

BIO :

This Brussels-based artist was born in 1947 and died of cancer on 11 December 2011. A multi-talented woman, she was the Belgian tennis champion in 1965. She developed an interest in astrology and tarot. During the final years of her life, she successfully tried her hand at writing several short stories. However, her true passion was painting.

CAREER :

She studied artistic techniques and then worked with charcoal for a year at the Royal Academy of Fine Arts. She also completed her training by studying commercial art.

WORK :

Joëlle Van Landeghem was particularly fond of the world of the Impressionists and worked 'in their style', making no secret of it. She regularly visited Giverny, to Claude Monet's estate, and would return with an armful of shimmering colours. Looking at her paintings, one feels calmer, more serene, as if nature had rubbed off on us. It was her final wish that the proceeds from the sale of her paintings be donated in full to the palliative care unit at the Clinique St. Pierre in Ottignies.
