Michel Dumont, Official Painter of the Navy, was born in 1946 into a family of photographers in Brussels. A great-uncle from Antwerp, who became Director of the Port of Marseille, introduced him to the Mediterranean coastline at an early age. It was there that he took his first steps in 'pointu' (traditional fishing boat). His studies in graphic design at the Institut Saint-Luc gave him his technical foundation, and it was through photography that he naturally moved on to painting, in which essential shapes and colours are highlighted with precision.

Michel Dumont has pursued a career in graphic arts, which is clearly evident in his works. From the Mediterranean to the Atlantic, he discovered the bright, contrasting colours of maritime architecture, with a predilection for trawlers and 'pointus' (he has just been named an Honorary Member of the Association pour la Sauvegarde du Pointu Provençal).

Awarded at the 36th Salon du Musée de la Marine in Paris, he has exhibited in Belgium (Boitsfort, Ixelles, Le Zoute) and France (Musée Portuaire de Dunkerque, Boyardville (Ile d'Oléron), Saint-Tropez (Musée de la Citadelle, Lavoir Vasserot, Salon des Artistes Contemporains)

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
